TK/TEDDE

Kindergarten Readiness Act of 2010 changed the required birthday for admission to Kindergarten and established a Transitional K program that began in 2012-2013 (Wiseburn has had a Transitional or TEDDE option of a 2 year modified curriculum developmentally appropriate for many years, with parent agreement)



A child will be enrolled in Transitional Kinder (TK) if they turn 5 between September 2 and December 2/



The ART of TEACHING Program:

In order to foster teaching excellence, the Cotsen Foundation for the ART of TEACHING offers two-year fellowships to groups of 5-7 teachers at selected schools. These teachers work with an assigned mentor for a minimum of 2 hours each week in an ongoing effort to improve their craft. The ART of TEACHING fellowship consists of several key components.



Math: Cognitively Guided Instruction (CGI)

It starts with what your students already know and builds on their natural number sense and intuitive approaches to problem solving. Rather than a math program or curriculum, CGI is a way of listening to students, asking smart questions, and engaging with their thinking—all with the goal of uncovering and expanding every student's mathematical understanding."






