  - a. Corrections/Clarifications
    - i. Snack Stand
      - 1. AYSO and Wiseburn Little League will each contribute \$3,000 per year for 10 years (total of \$30,000 each), commencing with the opening of the snack stand (expected in Spring 2012).

- a. Update on Cabrillo sinkhole dispute:
  - i. Dispute between Olivas (won bid) and Pipeline (subcontractor). Wiseburn School District named in lawsuit (has contract with Olivas, owes \$153,000 in retention money). Pipeline submitted claim for \$196,000. Lawsuit is scheduled to go to court, attorneys are trying to work out settlement.
- 4) Review / Discussion of Current Projects
  - a. Burnett Multipurpose Room
    - i. Need to upgrade school electrical service.
    - ii. Received DSA approval in June.
    - iii. Nine month project (hope to start construction in Oct 2011, end June 2012). Schedule depends on upgrade of electrical service.
    - iv. Expected cost: \$3.5 \$4.0 million (Measure A funds)
    - v. Expect to receive \$1.5 million in matching money from state. (May take a while to receive state matching money, need to wait until next statewide school bond measure passes.)
  - b. Wiseburn High School
    - i. Has El Segundo filed lawsuit? No, nothing to sue over. El Segundo requested Wiseburn School District look at other property (storm water retention basin located East of West Basin Water Reclamation Plant, South of Raytheon). Raytheon needs to move forward with plans to build road (in CEQA process).
